Annual report of Agricultural Sciences Forum of Kodagu for the year 2017—18

Good evening ladies and gentlemen,

At the outset I wish to place on record that our forum has successfully completed nineteen years. Currently the forum consists of 236 members, of which 21 are patrons.

I take this opportunity to present before you the annual report of the forum for the year 2017-18 from the time the present committee took over the management responsibility.

During 2017-18, seven executive committee meetings were held.

- The first combined EC meeting was held on 14-08-2017 at College of Forestry, Ponnampet for handing over of charges to the incoming EC members.
- The second EC meeting was held on 29-08-2017 at Anugraha, Lions Seva Bhavan, Pollibetta. The main agenda was to discuss about the Man- Animal conflict issues in Kodagu and put a representation to the Prime Ministers office, MoEF (both Central and State), and PCCF, Bengaluru in the form of a letter. A letter requesting for office space in the Forestry College premises was sent the Dean, College of Forestry, Ponnampet. A tentative programme schedule for the year 2017-18 wwas also worked out.
- Third EC meeting was held on 27-10-2017 at Anugraha, Lions Seva Bhavan, Pollibetta. The main agenda was to finalise the dates for Foundation day, ASFK Gold medal for topper in Forestry College and updating the members list.
- The foundation day was organized on 27-11-2017 at Palm Valley Resort, Pollibetta Road, Gonikkoal. **Prof. K Byrappa**, Hon. Vice Chancellor of Mangalore University was the chief guest. **Mr. Ravi Narayan from E-Thota** made a presentation on their activities especially focusing on a software application "plantation task management application" which could be used in managing the Coffee Plantation.T
- The fourth EC meeting was held on 11-01-2018 at Anugraha, Lions Seva Bhavan, Pollibetta. The main agenda was to finalise the proposed Irrigation seminar, sponsored by Rivulus India.
- The Fifth EC meeting was held on 09-02-2018 at Kodava Samaja, Ammathi to review the progress of organizing the seminar "More crop per drop: A seminar on Irrigation and Nutrient management on coffee and Black Pepper".
- The Sixth EC meeting was held on 27-03-2018 at Anugraha, Lions Seva Bhavan, Polibetta, to compile the success of the Irrigation seminar and to decide on the future course of action. The committee members also decided to organize an On-farm training programme on Nutrient management in Pepper and Coffee involving Dr. Sunil Tamagale from Scientific Agro Solutions.
- The Seventh EC meeting was held on 30-05-2018 at College of Forestry, Ponnampet to finalize the date and Venue for the On-farm training on Nutrient management in Pepper and Coffee. The idea of initiating a commercial venture with regard to establishing a ASFK Agro-Input shop was discussed. The EC members have approved the same.
